


# THE CAMPUS CLOTHES LINE LAUNDRY 101

## GET READY TO WASH



- ❑ Check garment care tags for specific instructions
- ❑ Separate clothing according to color and fabric type  
**HINT:** Mixing light and dark colors may cause colors to bleed
- ❑ Zip zippers, button buttons and remove all items from pockets
- ❑ Check for stains and pre-treat accordingly

## WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

- ❑ Load washer leaving about 5" of space from the top
- ❑ Add detergent (and bleach and fabric softener if desired)  
**HINT: SAVE YOUR SOAP!** Use only 2 tbsp. of eco-friendly  detergent for best results. Too much detergent can ruin clothing and damage the washers
- ❑ Select your cycle



Settings	Water Temperature
Whites	Hot
Colors	Warm
Perm-Press	Warm
Delicates	Warm
Bright Colors	Cold 
Woolens	Cold 

 **HINT: Be Clean & Green!**  
Cold water cycles clean effectively and save energy

**\*NOTE** Once you submit payment and select a cycle, the machine will remain locked until cycle completion

## DRYING INSTRUCTIONS

- ❑ Clean the lint screen to ensure maximum air flow is achieved to dry quickly and save energy
- ❑ Check garment tags to be sure heat drying is appropriate
- ❑ One washer load = one dryer load  
**HINT:** Clothing needs to move freely to dry efficiently
- ❑ Do not place garments with remaining stains in dryer; the heat will set the stain. Re-treat and re-wash.
- ❑ Do not dry wool, rubber, or plastic items.



Load Type	Dryer Setting
Whites & Colors	Hot setting
Permanent Press	Medium setting
Delicates	Low setting

**HINT:** Hot setting may cause shrinkage; use only with highly durable fabrics, such as towels

## LAUNDRY ETIQUETTE

- ❑ Remove clothing from the washer/dryer promptly  
**HINT:** Use LaundryView® Text Alerts as a reminder if available
- ❑ Leave the front-load washer door open to help the drum dry quickly
- ❑ Wipe detergent spills etc.
- ❑ Report service problems to ensure the machines get fixed and returned to service quickly
